

# NITK carries out 'Clean Coast Safe Sea' drive



MANGALURU: NITK, Surathkal joined hands with Swachh Sagar, Surakshit Sagar or Clean Coast Safe Sea campaign along with Karnataka Coast in association with Centre for Marine Living Resources and Ecology (CMLRE), Ministry of Earth Sciences (MoES), Kochi cleaned the Iddya beach near Mangaluru and also conducted various awareness campaigns.
