



NITK ring presentation ceremony-2024 held

Mangaluru: The ring presentation ceremony was held at NITK Surathkal on March 28. During the event, each graduating student was presented a silver ring with the NITK emblem and year of graduation etched on it. The silver rings were awarded to all the outgoing students from B.Tech (1015), M.Tech (756), MCA (62), MBA (55), M.Sc (65), M.Tech Research (32), and PhD programmes (122). During the ceremony, the best outgoing students of the year in several categories received (5) gold/silver medals, (2) received student prize funds and certificates. The event was graced by S S Nayak, a chartered accountant and senior partner at Ms S S Nayak and Associates as the chief guest, while Prof B Ravi, the director of NITK Surathkal, presided over the function.
